

## Executive summary

Hexagon's Safety, Infrastructure & Geospatial division is pleased to announce the release of ECW for ArcGIS Server 2023, available now for download.

ECW for ArcGIS Server is an add-on product sold to Esri Enterprise customers and provides ECW support within the Esri ArcGIS Enterprise platform (previously known as Esri ArcGIS for Server). ECW is Hexagon's industry-leading image compression format that enables users to compress terabytes of imagery by a factor up to 20x, while retaining full image quality and guaranteeing fast display performance.

Esri has chosen **not** to license the technology directly; therefore, this product addresses the significant market demand to benefit from Hexagon's ECW format within the Esri Server environment. The product supports both Windows or Linux deployments.

**This product is the only legal way Esri customers can serve ECW files via ArcGIS Enterprise.**

This release includes support for Esri v11.1+, and updates to the ECW SDK library and Geospatial Licensing requirements.

## Product summary

ECW for ArcGIS Server 2023 enhancements include:

- **Support for Esri's latest platform:** Due to incompatibilities between Esri release versions, this release targets Esri v11.1+ only
  - For v10.9 support, customers should continue using the ECW for ArcGIS Server 2020 release version
- **Updated ECW SDK library:** Users can benefit from a variety of bug fixes and performance improvements
- **Updated Geospatial Licensing:** Bugs have been resolved; the product now requires 16.8 licenses
